Grand Prairie Central Park is an example of a landmark destination in its community and the North Texas Metroplex. This new park sits on 172 acres of blackland prairie that includes a new public-safety facility and adult-activity center (The Summit) that will anchor the park as part of the cultural fabric for residents. The vision for the park features a 36 acre lake system as a scenic amenity that addresses regional flooding issues while collecting and cleansing the storm-water runoff from surrounding suburban neighborhoods. Through a holistic approach and resourceful planning, Central Park's mission, design, operations and maintenance created numerous recreational and educational opportunities to serve its community.

그랜드 프레리 센트럴 파크(Grand Prairie Central Park)는 이 지역사회와 북 텍사스 메트로플렉스(North Texas Metroplex)의 랜드마크이다. 새로운 공원 부지는 172acres의 흑토 대초원 지대이며, 공공 안전 시설과 주민들을 위한 활동센터 및 문화 장소로 자리하고 있다. 공원이 가지고 있는 비전은 36acres에 달하는 지역 홍수 문제에 대처하면서 동시에 주변 교외지역에서 빗물을 수거해 세척하는 우수 시스템이다. 전체적인 접근방식과 자원이 풍부한 계획을 통해 센트럴 파크의 미션, 디자인, 운영 및 유지관리는 수많은 여가 및 교육 기회를 지역사회에 제공한다.
